DOG REQUIREMENTS

1. For your dog's safety, we encourage the participation of dogs that are accustomed to regular exercise and are well adjusted to crowds and noisy environments with large numbers of people and other dogs.
2. Dogs must be current on all shots & rabies vaccination.
3. Dog must wear an ID Tag.
4. No dogs in heat.
5. No aggressive dogs.
6. No dogs under six months of age.
7. Dogs must be leashed (6 ft. max length) & in control. No retractable leashes please.
8. You must pick up after your dog. Encourage others to do the same!
9. A walker can have no more than two dogs under his or her control and children must be 12 yrs old or older to walk one dog with adult supervision.
10. We reserve the right to remove any dog from the walk that we feel is:
 - a) Posing a threat to the safety of other people and dogs.
 - b) Physically unfit to participate in the walk
